We have four camp locations that are located in Central and Eastern North Carolina.

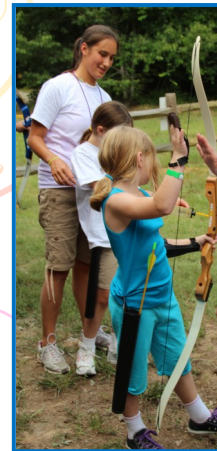

ASSISTANT CAMP DIRECTOR

Assists Camp Director to supervise staff and daily operations of camp. Applicants should have a college degree or equivalent, previous camp and supervisory experience, and organizational skills. Minimum age: 21. Salary range: \$270-335 per week.



PROGRAM DIRECTOR

Coordinate and direct camp program. Assist unit staff, arts and crafts director, and waterfront staff with weekly schedules. Supervise unit staff and assist in all phases of camp operation. Minimum age: 21. Salary Range: \$250-290 per week.

HEALTH SUPERVISOR

Administer a health and safety program for campers and staff members and maintain records of all medical activities. Requires state license and registration as a physician, physician's assistant, LPN, EMT, RN, or nurse practitioner. Minimum age: 21. Salary range: \$310-410 per week.

BUSINESS MANAGER/DRIVER

Supervise trading post sales and inventory. Process orders for camp supplies. Assist in driving units to outside program locations. Minimum age: 21. Salary range: \$230-310 per week.

CAMP LEADERSHIP DIRECTOR

Leads training program for girls ages 15-17 who want to become camp counselors. Must have previous camp counselor experience, leadership and supervisory skills; Counselor-In-Training (CIT) experience desirable. Minimum age: 21. Salary range: \$235-270 per week.



UNIT LEADER

Plan and coordinate unit program with campers and unit staff. Supervise unit staff. Responsible for the direct, daily supervision of girls in the living unit and program areas. Minimum age: 21. Salary range: \$235-285 per week.



ASSISTANT UNIT LEADER

Works as a member of the unit staff team to assist with programs. Responsible for daily, direct supervision of girls in living and program areas. Minimum age: 18. Salary range: \$195-240 per week.

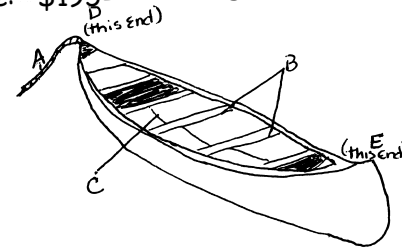


WATERFRONT DIRECTOR

Direct and coordinate water activities for all age levels. Supervise waterfront staff. Keep American Red Cross records as necessary. Responsible for the management and maintenance of the pool. Minimum age: 21. Salary range: \$250-310 per week.

WATERFRONT COUNSELOR

Assists Waterfront Director. Supervises girls in waterfront activities. Has evening duties with campers. Interested applicants should have appropriate certifications for example: Lifeguard training; first aid and CPR; WSI, and sailing or canoeing experience helpful. Minimum age: 18. Salary range: \$200-240 per week.



ADVENTURE STAFF

Delivery of adventure trips for teens by assisting in management, planning and the physical operation of the trips and related equipment. Must be responsible, organized, have previous camp experience, and can drive a 12 passenger van. Minimum age: 21. Salary range: \$235-335 per week.

ARTS AND CRAFTS DIRECTOR

Plan, coordinate, and direct arts and crafts activities for all age levels. Assist with unit and all camp programs as needed. Responsible for care, use, and purchase of all arts and crafts supplies and equipment. Minimum age: 18. Salary range: \$235-285 per week.



KITCHEN SUPERVISOR

Order necessary food and supplies. Oversee kitchen staff. Prepare food based on daily menu. Responsible for maintaining cleanliness in kitchen and dining area. Minimum age: 21. Salary range: \$260-310 per week.

COOK

Assist in general preparation of food. Assists in maintaining cleanliness in kitchen and dining area. Minimum age: 18. Salary range: \$210-260 per week.

KITCHEN AIDE

Helps in food preparation and serving. Washes dishes. Assist in keeping kitchen and dining room clean. Minimum age: 16. Salary range: \$110-175 per week.
