How Your Troop Can Take Action in honor of the 100th:

Step One

- Review the list of Service Projects and discuss with your troop which service projects are of interest to them. These projects are just suggestions and can be modified to fit your troop and your community. Of course, girls are encouraged to suggest projects that they would like to complete throughout the year even if they are not included in the list.

Step Two

- Make the Pledge! Let us know the service project(s) your troop will undertake in honor of our 100th Anniversary.

Step Three

- Track your hours. As your troop volunteers their time to fulfill the pledge, be sure to note the hours spent on each project. A “Take Action for the 100th” tracking sheet that you can keep for your records is enclosed at the end of this packet.
