

**VOLUNTEER POSITION DESCRIPTION  
GIRL SCOUTS GIVE CHAMPION**

<b>SUMMARY:</b>	The Girl Scouts Give Champion is responsible for planning, marketing, and managing the Girl Scouts Give campaign in their assigned service area.
<b>TERM OF APPOINTMENT:</b>	The Girl Scouts Give Champion is appointed for a term of one program year but may be eligible for reappointment.
<b>ACCOUNTABILITY:</b>	The Girl Scouts Give Champion is accountable to the Service Unit Manager, Membership Director or Manager, and Fund Development Manager.
<b>RESPONSIBILITIES:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Raise awareness of and motivate participation in the Girl Scouts Give campaign</li> <li>• Work in partnership with the Service Unit Manager, Membership Director or Manager, and Fund Development staff to set strategy, goals, and appropriate marketing</li> <li>• Provide ongoing campaign updates at service unit/area meetings</li> <li>• Maintain giving site, including customized messaging, pictures, reports (or work with the Fund Development Manager if an offline campaign works better for the area)</li> <li>• Collect and deliver funds to the council as needed</li> <li>• Remain informed about and comply with all current policies, procedures, and guidelines (<i>Volunteer Essentials</i> and <i>Safety Activity Checkpoints</i>) of Girl Scouts – North Carolina Coastal Pines and GSUSA and adhere to all Council Fund Raising standards</li> </ul>
<b>QUALIFICATIONS AND CORE COMPETENCIES:</b>	<p><b>Girl-led Focus:</b> Empower, encourage, and guide girls and volunteers to understand Girl Scouts’ girl-led, learn-by-doing, and cooperative approach to developing a girl’s leadership skills.</p> <p><b>Personal Integrity:</b> Serve as a role model for volunteers guided by the Girl Scout Mission, Promise, and Law - modeling reliability, dependability, honesty, credibility, respect for others, respect for self, inclusivity, positivity, and a spirit of collaboration.</p> <p><b>Adaptability:</b> Adjust, modify your behavior and remain flexible and tolerant in changing situations and environments.</p> <p><b>Oral Communication:</b> Practice positive communication skills and express ideas clearly and accurately.</p> <p><b>Foster Diversity, Equity, Inclusion, Belonging, and Racial Justice:</b> Understand, respect, and embrace individual differences</p> <p><b>Additional Requirements:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Registered member of GSUSA and a valid background check</li> <li>• Completion of any required training assigned and provided by Girl Scouts – North Carolina Coastal Pines and GSUSA</li> <li>• Email, internet, and texting capabilities for consistent and effective communication, document sharing, and research</li> </ul>
