Use music to move people to action

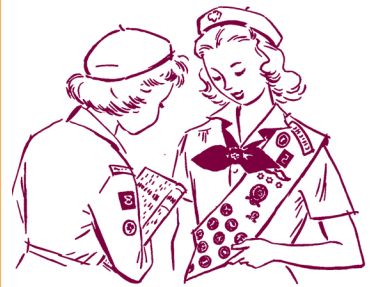
Throughout history songs have helped rally people to causes. Find songs that help give voice to hope and concerns learn their history and think about how and why they inspire.
