WHAT IS DAY CAMP?

Learning... Growing... Crafts... Singing... New friends... Outdoor skills... Games... Ceremonies... Lots of Fun!

COST:

\$75.00 for registered Girl Scouts (Grades K - 12th)
\$100.00 for non-Girl Scouts (includes \$25.00 for Girl Scout registration fee)
Cost includes Day Camp patch, t-shirt and all program opportunities.
\$25.00 deposit required. Deposit is non-refundable after June 25, 2021.

TRANSPORTATION:

Furnished by parents. Carpool when possible.
Temperature checks will be taken before the camper can leave the vehicle. All vehicles are to park in the main parking lot. Adults are to walk campers to their check in points. Campers **MUST BE** signed in and signed out each day. Please follow the signs. Please be patient as this is a new process.

HOW TO REGISTER:

Online registration only on Girl Scout website- opens on March 1st.
(www.nccoastalpines.org). **REGISTRATION PERIOD: March 1, 2021 to June 25, 2021 OR until camp is full.** No registrations will be accepted after this time. **Girls will be placed on a first come first served basis.** Due to COVID, camp is only accepting 80% capacity. A waitlist will be kept.
Confirmation with detailed information about Day Camp will be mailed/emailed to all registered campers starting April 4, 2021.

WHAT TO BRING

Bag lunch and drink – label with child's name. We do not suggest sending microwavable foods.
Reusable water bottle, one-piece bathing suit or tankini where the top touches the bottom & beach towel (or must wear a t-shirt/rash guard over a two-piece)
Sunscreen – waterproof and at least SPF 15, Insect Repellent – no aerosol cans
Remember to label all things with child's name.

WHAT TO WEAR:

Masks are required this year unless otherwise noted.
Socks and shoes (NO sandals or open-toe/open-heel shoes)
Comfortable, weather-appropriate clothing, Rainwear (we will have camp rain or shine), Hat/Cap or bandana

HEALTH STATEMENT:

Once you have registered for camp, you will need to fill out a Health History Form. Please fill out the form completely, including signatures, and return to the day camp director at the address given on the form. Any child on daily medication should complete the medication portion and bring medication to camp clearly marked with detailed instructions. The Health Supervisor administers all medications. Make copies of forms as needed. Additional safety precautions will be taken this year (i.e. hand sanitizer, temperature checks, mask wearing and social distancing)
