WHAT IS DAY CAMP?

Learning... Growing... Crafts... Singing... Dancing... New friends... Archery...

Canoeing... Water Games... Lots of Fun!

COST: \$85.00 for registered Girl Scouts (Grades K - 12th)

\$110.00 for non-Girl Scouts (includes \$25.00 for Girl Scout registration fee) \$20.00 for PA's and PAT's (Additional PAT training registration required) Costs include Day Camp patch, t-shirt, 2 snacks each day and Friday lunch.

Camperships are available and can be applied for as part of the <u>registration process</u>.

TRANSPORTATION: Furnished by parents. Carpool when possible.

All vehicles are to line up to the side of the shut gate. It will open promptly at 8:45 to allow you down to drop off campers. Please line up there in the afternoons also. The gate will open promptly at 4:00 PM to allow you to drive down to pick up campers.

HOW TO REGISTER: Online registration on My GS opens on March 1st. (www.nccoastalpines.org).

REGISTRATION PERIOD: March 1, 2021 to May 1, 2021. No registrations will be accepted after this time.

Girls will be placed on a first come first served basis. There will be a waitlist

available for campers and PA's.

Confirmations with detailed information about Day Camp will be mailed/emailed to

all registered campers starting April 15, 2021.

WHAT TO BRING

NEW THIS YEAR: Girls will bring their own reusable water bottle and day pack

each day. Also, each day girls wear swimsuits under their clothes; one-piece bathing suit or tankini where the top touches the bottom (or must wear a t-shirt/rash guard over a two-piece) Additional items to bring: plastic bag for wet items, water shoes, beach towel. Sunscreen – waterproof and at least SPF 15, Insect Repellent – no aerosol cans (Recommended product: a 2-in-1 like Bullfrog.) Lunches in reusable

bags (no meat, no mayo) Remember to label <u>ALL</u> things with child's name.

WHAT TO WEAR: Socks and shoes (NO sandals or open-toe/open-heel shoes)

Comfortable, weather-appropriate clothing, Rainwear (we will have camp rain or shine), Baseball caps are best. Masks are required this year unless otherwise noted.

HEALTH STATEMENT: Once you have registered for camp, you will need to fill out a Health History Form.

Please fill out the form completely, including signatures, and return to the day camp director. Any child on daily medication which will be taken at camp should complete the medication portion and bring medication to camp clearly marked with detailed instructions. The camp nurse administers all medications. Epi-pens will be given to

unit leaders. Make copies of forms as needed.
