

The Svalbard Global Seed Vault | Svalbard, Norway

The Svalbard Global Seed Vault is a treasure trove of biodiversity—the scientists here protect over 865,000 seed samples from almost every country on Earth.

NASA Lyndon B. Johnson Space Center | Houston, TX

<u>The Johnson Space Center</u> is where NASA scientists conduct research and training on human spaceflight.

Amundsen-Scott South Pole Station | Antarctica

<u>Take a tour</u> of the southern-most research station in the world! The South Pole Station was founded in 1956 and is fully staffed by scientists year-round.

International Space Station

Orbiting Earth, the <u>International Space Station</u> is a home to scientists carrying out specialized research from around the world.

CERN: Large Hadron Collider | France & Switzerland

Located underground on the border between France and Switzerland, CERN scientists conduct research on physics and nuclear power using the <u>Large Hadron Collider</u>.

<u>Aquarius Reef Base | Key Largo, Florida</u>

The only underwater research lab in the world! Scientists at the Aquarius Reef Base live on the sea floor while they conduct underwater research.
