

Camp Property Descriptions

Camp Graham

9 334 Regional Water Lane, Henderson, NC 27537

Located on the scenic shores of Kerr Lake in Vance County, Camp Graham offers 155 acres of forest, coves, and open fields. The camp features a semi-private waterfront ideal for canoeing, kayaking, and sailing. With ample space for large group activities, Camp Graham accommodates up to 206 campers across two tent units, three cabin units, a CIT hut, and a staff house. Overnight camp is hosted here during the summer season.





Camp Hardee

? 752 Camp Hardee Road, Blounts Creek, NC 27814

Situated southeast of Chocowinity and Washington, Camp Hardee spans 96 acres along the Pamlico River. The property includes riverfront access, wooded areas, and open fields suitable for group gatherings. All facilities and activity areas are within easy walking distance, and the camp can host up to 96 campers.


Camp Mary Atkinson

9 8591 NC Hwy 42 East, Selma, NC 27576

Camp Mary Atkinson is located in Johnston County, just east of Clayton. Covering 278 acres, the camp features a swimming pool, boating pond, wooded trails, and the Leadership Center. Lodging includes two cabin units, three tent units, and a staff house, supporting up to 204 campers. The site is well-equipped for programming and large group events, with overnight camp held during the summer months.



Camp Mu-Sha-Ni



9 218 Sycamore Lane, Jackson Springs, NC 27281

Camp Mu-Sha-Ni is nestled in the Sandhills region of Richmond County, approximately 10 miles west of Aberdeen. This expansive 843-acre property includes fields, forests, ponds, and wetlands. Lodging options include six platform tent units and two buildings, with additional space for up to 300 campers in the Encampment Field. The Troop House and Chalfant Shelter offer year-round comfort with heating and air conditioning.

Camp Graham Lodging

Cardinal Cove: Platform Tents

Capacity: 16

Cardinal Cove is a cozy tent unit nestled between the infirmary and the swinging bridge, offering scenic views of Kerr Lake and the swimming and boating areas. The unit includes four platform tents, each with four cots and mattresses, arranged around a central fire circle for cooking and gathering. A picnic table is nearby for outdoor meals.



Outdoor showers are located close by. Portable toilets are available during the summer, and the main restrooms are a short walk away. During other seasons, campers use the restroom and shower facilities in the infirmary.

Note: Cardinal Cove is closed during the winter and summer seasons.



CIT Cabin

Capacity: 10

Located near the Dining Hall and surrounded by trees, the CIT Cabin offers shade, privacy, and a peaceful setting for small groups and leadership outings. It features bunk beds with mattresses and sleeping areas at each end of the cabin. A central bathroom with a shower and toilet adds convenience.

Behind the cabin, a fire ring and benches provide the perfect spot for campfire cooking and s'mores. Renovated in 2021, the cabin now includes heating and air conditioning for year-round comfort during open seasons.

Note: The CIT Cabin is closed during the winter and summer seasons.

Cloverfield Treehouses

Capacity: 36 in cabins (plus 8 in platform tents)

The Cloverfield Treehouse Unit features six elevated cabins, each named after a native North Carolina tree. Each cabin sleeps six and includes bunk beds, cots with mattresses, a bench, and a ceiling fan. The central Brightleaf Program Shelter offers electricity, tables, chairs, a refrigerator, and fans.



Outdoor amenities include picnic tables, grills, and a fire circle. Beneath the shelter is a shower house with four warm-water stalls and handwashing sinks. While the cabins are not heated, the bathrooms are. The unit is ADA-compliant with a wheelchair ramp and lift.

Note: Closed during summer; available in spring and fall.



Holly Hill

Capacity: 48

Holly Hill is a wooded unit near Kerr Lake with seven cabins, all equipped with electricity and ceiling fans. Cabins 1, 6, and 7 sleep eight (bunks and cots), while Cabins 2–5 sleep six (cots only). The unit shelter includes tables, chairs, electricity, fans, a refrigerator, an indoor/outdoor fireplace, and a patio.

Campers can enjoy two fire circles for cooking or campfires. The bathhouse features three toilets, three showers, and a separate ADA-compliant bathroom with a shower.

Note: Closed in winter and summer; available in spring and fall.

Infirmary

Capacity: 12

Renovated in 2022, the Infirmary includes two large rooms and a small gathering area. It offers six sets of bunk beds, accommodating up to 12 campers. The building is fully heated and air-conditioned and includes an on-site restroom with a shower.



Note: Closed during the winter and summer seasons.



Staff House

Capacity: 20

Located next to the summer office on the main camp road, the Staff House offers a lake view from the front yard and a welcoming indoor space. It features an open room with a fireplace, tables, chairs, couches, a large TV, and a DVD player. Mattresses are stored in a closet and can be used on the floor for sleeping.

The cabin includes a bathroom with a toilet, shower, and sink. The fully equipped kitchen has pots, pans, dishes, utensils, a refrigerator, microwave, stove, dishwasher, and dishwashing sink. Heated for comfort, the fireplace adds extra warmth during colder months. Outside, guests can enjoy a fire circle and picnic tables.

Note: Closed during the summer season.

Trailblazer

Capacity: 42

Nestled among the trees near main camp, Trailblazer offers both privacy and convenience. The unit includes seven cabins, each with six cots and mattresses, electricity, and ceiling fans. Cabins are arranged in a circle around the unit shelter, which features electricity, tables, chairs, indoor and outdoor fireplaces, a refrigerator, and a patio.



Nearby amenities include an open-air shower house with four stalls, a multi-person sink, and a dishwashing sink. The toilet house includes four toilets and a handwashing sink. Two fire circles and picnic tables are available for cooking and gatherings. A large grassy field provides space for games and activities.

Note: Closed during the winter and summer seasons.

Welcome Center



Capacity: 12

Located at the entrance of camp, the Welcome Center is a cozy retreat ideal for small troops. With a capacity of 12 campers, it features three bedrooms with a mix of bunk and single beds, offering flexible sleeping arrangements for both youth and adults.

The full kitchen and gathering area make it a perfect spot for weekend fun, shared meals, and troop bonding. Equipped with heating and air conditioning, the Welcome Center provides year-round comfort in a convenient location.

Note: Closed during the summer season.

Whippoorwill

Capacity: 40

Located in the heart of camp with views of all major buildings, Whippoorwill is an ADA-accessible unit featuring ten platform tents, each with four cots and mattresses. The unit shelter includes electricity, tables, chairs, fans, indoor/outdoor fireplaces, a patio, and a refrigerator.



Behind the shelter is an open-air shower house with four showers, a multi-faucet sink, and a

dishwashing sink. The nearby toilet house includes four flush toilets, with one tent, toilet, and shower, ADA-accessible.

Note: Closed during the winter and summer seasons.



Crisp Cabin

Capacity: 8

Crisp Cabin is a cozy 3-bedroom, 2-bath modular home designed for year-round comfort with heating and air conditioning. It features a fully stocked kitchen and a welcoming dining area for up to eight guests.



Sleeping arrangements include one bedroom with two bunk beds and two bedrooms with two cots each. Guests can relax in the living room or enjoy outdoor amenities like a charcoal grill, picnic tables, and a shared fire circle—perfect for group gatherings and campfire fun.

Cabin 1: Hardee Hotel

Capacity: 8


Hardee Hotel offers four sets of bunk beds with mattresses and a wall-mounted HVAC unit for heating and cooling. This cabin includes two charcoal grills and one picnic table. Guests use the nearby community bathhouse, shared with other groups.



Cabin 2

Capacity: 16

Cabin 2 is ideal for larger groups or first-time campers. It includes eight sets of bunk beds with mattresses and is equipped with both heating and air conditioning. Adults may share the cabin with campers in accordance with Safety Activity Checkpoints. This cabin also uses the community bathhouse.



Capacity: 24 (8 per cabin)

Unit 1 includes Cabins 3, 4, 5, and 6, each with four sets of bunk beds and mattresses. All cabins are heated and air-conditioned. Cabins 3, 4, and 5 are clustered around a shared campfire circle, two charcoal grills, and a picnic table. All cabins in Unit 1 share the community bathhouse.





Cabins 7–10- Unit 2

Capacity: 32 (8 per cabin)

Our newly renovated Creativity Corner: A Place of Imagination & Warmth (Arts and Crafts Shelter) will continue serving its essential role to enrich the arts and crafts experience. Renovations include a new roof, concrete pad flooring, outdoor-rated fans and lights, and open-air walls with screens to facilitate air flow and enhance the view, with the option of clear covers on days



Camp Mary Atkinson Lodging

Coyote Hill



Capacity: 20

Covote Hill is located just up the hill from Fox Leap and can be added to that unit when extra space is needed. It includes five screened platform tents, each with four cots and mattresses. The unit shelter sits centrally and features electricity, a refrigerator, and a picnic table. Cooking amenities include two ground grills and a fire circle tucked behind the shelter near the woods.

Coyote Hill shares toilet and shower facilities with Fox Leap. The bathhouse includes three toilets and three showers in the main bathroom, plus an ADA-compliant single-stall bathroom and shower.

Note: Closed during the winter and summer seasons.

Fox Leap

Capacity: 28

Fox Leap features seven screened platform tents, each with four cots and mattresses, arranged in a semi-circle around a central fire circle. The unit shelter includes electricity, a fireplace, picnic tables, and a refrigerator. Cooking is supported by four ground grills.



The bathhouse, shared with Coyote Hill, includes three toilets and three showers in the main bathroom, plus an ADA-compliant single-stall bathroom and shower. Fox Leap is shaded by a canopy of hardwoods and pine trees and is located near the lake.

Note: Closed during the winter and summer seasons.



Lady Slipper

Capacity: 40

Lady Slipper includes ten screened platform tents, each with four cots and mattresses, arranged around the unit shelter. The shelter features a fireplace, picnic tables, and a refrigerator. Nearby, campers will find a fire circle and four ground grills for cooking.

The bathhouse includes three toilets and three showers in the main bathroom, plus an ADA-compliant single-stall bathroom and shower. One tent is ADAaccessible. Lady Slipper is located near the Alpine Tower trail and shaded by large pine and oak trees.

Note: Closed during the winter and summer seasons.



Owl Hollow

Capacity: 60

Owl Hollow includes five cabins, each with three bunk beds and six cots with mattresses. Cabins are equipped with ceiling fans, lights, covered porches, heating, and air conditioning. The enclosed unit shelter offers electricity, a refrigerator, a fireplace, and climate control.

The bathhouse includes four toilets, four showers, two outdoor showers, and five handwashing sinks, and is heated for winter use. Outdoor amenities include picnic tables, four ground grills, and a fire circle. Owl Hollow is ADA-accessible and located in a shaded area near the river and lake.

Note: Closed during the summer season.


Raccoon Loft

Capacity: 36

Raccoon Loft includes six cabins, each with six cots and mattresses. Cabins have electricity and lights and are arranged around the unit shelter and bathhouse. The shelter features a fireplace, picnic tables, and a refrigerator.

The bathhouse includes three toilets and three showers in the main bathroom, plus an ADA-compliant single-stall

bathroom and shower. Cooking amenities include four ground grills and a fire circle. The unit is shaded by large oak trees and located between the lake and the activity field.





Staff House

Capacity: 20

The Staff House features an open room with a fireplace, tables, chairs, and couches. Mattresses are stored in a closet and can be laid out on the floor for sleeping. The cabin includes two toilets, one shower, two sinks, and cubby shelving for personal items.

The full kitchen is equipped with pots, pans, dishes, utensils, a refrigerator, microwave, non-commercial stove, and a dishwashing sink. Heated for winter comfort, the fireplace adds extra warmth. Outside, there is a fire circle, two grills, and two picnic tables.

The Trees
Capacity: 14

Perfect for small group getaways, The Trees offers cozy, newly renovated accommodations for up to 14 campers. This charming building features three bedrooms with two bunks each, plus a separate room with two single beds, making it ideal for troop leaders or chaperones.

With two full bathrooms and year-round heating and air conditioning, campers can enjoy comfort and convenience in every season. Whether you're gathering for a weekend retreat or planning a quiet escape, The Trees provides a peaceful home base for your camp experience.



Chalfant Shelter Unit

Capacity: 16

Chalfant Shelter is located on the far side of the pond, offering a peaceful and private setting. This ADA-accessible unit features one main room with heating and air conditioning. Mattresses are available and can be placed on the floor for sleeping. The shelter includes a fireplace, refrigerator, oven, microwave, folding tables and chairs, picnic tables, charcoal grills, and water faucets.

A nearby toilet/shower facility is just steps from the covered porch. Also close by is a fire circle and an additional shelter with benches, lights, and electricity.

Note: Available year-round.

Troop House

Capacity: 50 (Day Use) / 30 (Overnight)

The Troop House is a modern, ADA-accessible building overlooking the camp's pond. Ramps connect to each end of the wrap-around porch, which features rocking chairs for relaxing and enjoying the view. Inside, the 2,400-square-foot heated and cooled space includes a large open room with mattresses available for floor sleeping. Tables and chairs are stored in a nearby closet.



A large fireplace anchors one end of the common room, surrounded by comfortable furniture. The kitchen is fully equipped with three ovens, a dishwasher, a microwave, a commercial refrigerator, and a small freezer. Restroom facilities include three toilets and handwashing sinks, plus a unisex ADA-accessible shower/toilet/sink room. A nearby shelter includes benches and electricity.

Note: Available year-round.



Blue Bird Unit

Capacity: 20

Blue Bird is located between the parking lot and Encampment Field, close to the large bathhouse. It includes platform tents with four cots and mattresses each. The unit can be used independently or combined with Red Bird (up to 40 campers) or with both Red Bird and Fox Squirrel Den (up to 52 campers).

Nearby shelters offer amenities such as brick charcoal grills, picnic tables, fire circles, water spigots, electric outlets, lights, and fans.

Note: Closed during the winter season.

Fox Squirrel Den Unit

Capacity: 12

Fox Squirrel Den is located at the corner of Encampment Field and includes three platform tents, each with four cots and mattresses. A nearby open shelter provides water access, picnic tables, a fire circle, and a charcoal grill. This unit can be used alone or combined with Red Bird and Blue Bird for up to 52 campers.

Painted Tree Unit

Capacity: 12

Painted Tree is tucked into a young hardwood and pine woodlot at the far end of Encampment Field. It includes three platform tents with four cots and mattresses each. Nearby amenities include a small fire circle, charcoal grill, picnic table, and water spigot.

Bird Unit

Capacity: 20

Red Bird is located between the parking lot and Encampment Field, near the bathhouse. It includes platform tents with four cots and mattresses each. The unit can be used alone or combined with Blue Bird (up to 40 campers) or with Blue Bird and Fox Squirrel Den (up to 52 campers).



The unit shelter includes electric outlets, lights, fans, picnic tables, benches, charcoal grills, a water spigot, and a large fire circle shared with Blue Bird.

Spotted Fawn Unit



Capacity: 16

Spotted Fawn is located just past Turkey Hollow at the far end of Encampment Field. It includes four platform tents with four cots and mattresses each. Program/Activity Areas included in Rentals

Community Bathhouse

Conveniently located near the Encampment Field, this ADA-accessible bathhouse includes:

- 8 showers, 8 toilets, and 11 hand-washing sinks
- 4 automatic hand dryers and gas wall heaters for cool-weather campers
 - *Closed in winter. Shared by all campers—everyone helps keep it clean!





Chalfant Bathhouse

Located near Chalfant Shelter, this heated, ADA-accessible bathhouse includes:

One side with a shower and two toilets Another side with a single shower and toilet Open year-round for camper comfort.

Large Picnic Shelter

Located at the front of the Encampment Field near the pond, this spacious shelter includes:

- Electric outlets, lighting, fan
- Large cooking grills, picnic tables, and benches
- Cooking fire circle and water faucet nearby
- Perfect for crafts, group meals, and event check-ins.

Explore the natural beauty of camp on three marked trails:


- Yellow Trail 2 miles
