<b>Introduction</b>	Addition of "Introduction to Volunteer Policies."	To help explain the value and intended usage of this document
<b><u>I - Adults in Girl Scouting - "Girl Scouts E.P.I.C. Culture"</u></b>	Eliminated the word "encourage" when describing our expectation for all members to always model "EPIC" behavior.	Now reads as more of a required level of behavior. Also cited now is the location of additional information on E.P.I.C. behavior.
<b><u>I - Adults in Girl Scouting - "Uniforms"</u></b>	Deleted language indicating that uniforms were not required.	Based on recent communication from GSUSA. Uniform requirements based on the information listed on the GSUSA website were listed.
<b><u>II - Protection for Girls and Adults - "Social Media"</u></b>	Addition of "Social Media" section.	Added to address growing conflicts happening throughout social media.
<b><u>IV - Financial Policies - "Money Earning Activities"</u></b>	Statement added. Fourth paragraph.	Added to reflect money-earning exceptions on behalf of girls pursuing their Gold Award.
<b><u>IV - Financial Policies - "Stewardship of Funds"</u></b>	Section added.	Added to better define money-handling expectations and penalties as a result of having a debt.
