How to sign into TYNKER

1. Follow the link [here](#). Or go to www.tynker.com
2. You can create a free account if you want. If you do not want to create a free account you do not have to just got to step 3
3. Click Play button at top of screen it looks like a game controller.
4. Select your coding level
 - Never coded (beginner)
 - Coded Before (Intermediate)
 - Coded a lot (advanced).
5. Select the subjects you are interested in and start coding
6. Recommend you start in the section marked game design. With [Barbie can do anything](#) or Glitch Manor (glitch manor will require your parents or your email address).
