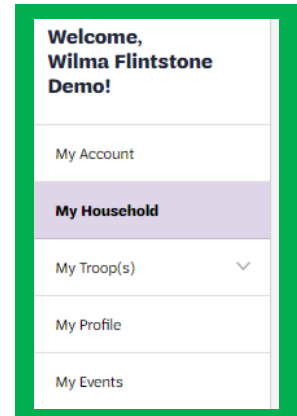


Council to Council Transfers

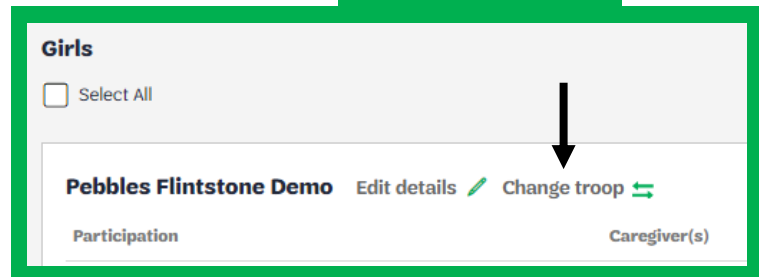
Moving? Taking your Girl Scout membership with you is now easy!

If you've already moved, then please take a minute to update the address for each member of your family.

- If you update one person, the others are not automatically updated. To update the address, sign in to your My GS account and select My Household from the menu on the left. Then select "Edit details" next to each family member to update their address.
- Don't have a new address? That's okay. As long as you know the zip code, you can still look at troops in the area. Want to contact your new council for more information? Use GSUSA's convenient [Council Finder](#).



From your My GS account, select My Household. For the first person that has a membership, select Change troop. You will repeat this process for each person that is moving a membership to your new home.



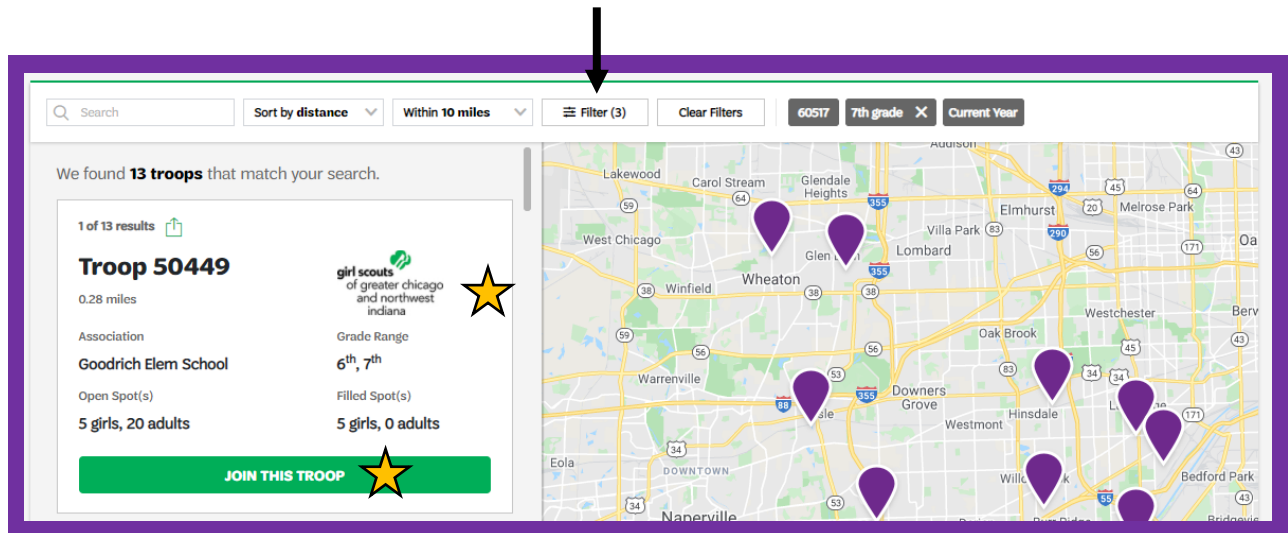
On the next screen, you will see the name of the person that you selected. You will see (or choose if it doesn't auto populate) the troop your Girl Scout is leaving. Then you will select the green Find Troop button at the bottom of the page.

On the next page, make sure the zip code is one near your new home. The search radius defaults to 10 miles and expands up to 90 miles. Verify the correct grade is selected. Then select the green Search button at the bottom of the page.

You will see a number of results displayed.

- At any time, you can select the Filter button to adjust your search filters.
- The logo next to the troop number shows the council affiliated with that troop.
- The pins on the map to the right represent the approximate location and are not exact.
- When you find a troop that will work for you select the green Join This Troop button for more information.



Once you've selected Join This Troop, be sure to confirm your selection on the next page.
