Girl Scouts-North Carolina Coastal Pines Board Development Committee is pleased to announce the call for National Delegates to represent our council at the 56<sup>th</sup> National Council Session in Orlando in July 2023.

### Make a Difference in Girl Scouting

GSUSA's National Council comes together every three years and consists of:

- delegates elected to represent their respective council
- delegates elected to represent USA Girl Scouts Overseas,
- members of the National Board of Directors,
- members of the National Board Development Committee, and
- past presidents of GSUSA.

All elected National Delegates serve a three-year term and must be US citizens and registered members of GSUSA, 14 years of age or older.

National Council members assume one of the most significant responsibilities in Girl Scouting. Through discussions and careful deliberation on issues that impact the Girl Scout Movement, National Council members reaffirm the partnership between Girl Scout councils and Girl Scouts of the USA and are accountable for:

- carefully preparing to participate in the democratic process at the National Council Session,
- opening their minds to the diverse opinions and perspectives of others, and
- voting as their conscience guides, keeping in mind the well-being and future development of the entire Girl Scout Movement and not any one particular council or group of councils.

### National Council Logistics and Expenses

Event expenses, to include all associated registration fees, round trip air transportation from the Raleigh-Durham Airport to the event, ground transportation to/from the Orlando airport to the hotel, and hotel accommodations and meals for elected National Delegates attending the GSUSA National Council Session will be paid for by Girl Scouts-North Carolina Coastal Pines.
